A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TAMARAC, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SEND A PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE OF 6.3752 MILS FOR GENERAL OPERATING PURPOSES AND A PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE OF 0.0801 MILS FOR VOTED DEBT SERVICE TO THE PROPERTY APPRAISER FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010, AND SETTING SEPTEMBER 14, 2009, AT 5:05 P.M. AT THE TAMARAC COMMISSION CHAMBERS, 7525 N.W. 88<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE, TAMARAC, FLORIDA, AS THE DATE, TIME AND PLACE FOR THE FIRST PUBLIC BUDGET HEARING; SETTING SEPTEMBER 23, 2009, AT 5:05 P.M. AT THE TAMARAC COMMISSION CHAMBERS, 7525 N.W. 88<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE, TAMARAC, FLORIDA AS THE DATE, TIME, AND PLACE FOR THE SECOND PUBLIC BUDGET HEARING; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 200.065 (TRIM – Truth in Millage) requires all municipalities, within 35 days of receipt of the city’s certification of taxable value (on or around July 1), to advise the Property Appraiser of a estimated millage rates to be included in the TRIM notice sent to each taxpayer; and

WHEREAS, estimated and tentative millage rates should be proposed which would allow the City Commission latitude in meeting Fiscal Year 2010 budgetary requirements; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 200.065 requires that a hearing date, other than that scheduled by the Broward County Commission and the Broward County School Board, be set by each municipality to be included in the TRIM Notice sent to each taxpayer; and

WHEREAS, the millage rate for general operating purposes is estimated to be 6.3752 mils for Fiscal Year 2010, and that the public budget hearings be set at 5:05 p.m. on September 14, and 5:05 p.m. on September 23, 2009, in the City Commission Chambers, 7525 N.W. 88<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Tamarac, Florida 33321; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Tamarac, Florida deems it to be in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the City of Tamarac to allow the City Manager to send an estimated and tentative millage rate of 6.3752 mils for general operating purposes and an estimated and tentative millage rate of 0.0801 mils for voted debt service to the Property Appraiser and to set a date, time, and place for the first and second public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TAMARAC, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are HEREBY ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are HEREBY made a specific part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2: The City Manager is authorized to send notification to the Property Appraiser of the estimated millage rate of 6.3752 mils for general operating purposes and the estimated millage rate of 0.0801 mils for voted debt service for Fiscal Year 2010, along with the date, time and place of the first Public Budget hearing being on September 14, 2009, at 5:05 p.m. at the City of Tamarac Commission Chambers, 7525 N.W. 88th Avenue, Tamarac, Florida 33321.


SECTION 3: The City Commission chooses September 23, 2009, at 5:05 p.m. at the City of Tamarac Commission Chambers, 7525 N.W. 88th Avenue, Tamarac, Florida 33321, as the date, time, and place for the second public budget hearing.

SECTION 4: All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are HEREBY repealed to the extent of such conflict.


