Thank you for requesting confidentiality from the Broward County Property Appraiser's Office (BCPA).

To exempt your information under Section 119.07, Florida Statutes, and shield it from public disclosure in our agency's database, each applicant must provide the following:

- 1. Fictitious Name BCPA will use a fictitious name, of your choosing, to be displayed within the BCPA database in place of your legal name. The fictitious name can be any name the post office will recognize to ensure delivery of important documents.
- 2. For those requesting confidentiality based on your current or former employment, we require written verification signed by your supervisor or Human Resources Department confirming your employment (see last page of the attached application). This verification requirement does not apply to judges and elected officials.
- 3. Copy of your employee ID card, law enforcement credentials, professional licensure, or other official documentation to prove you are eligible to have your information made confidential. If you are a victim of a crime, you must provide verification that the crime occurred.

Broward County's Recording Office -- which is independent of our office -- also offers confidentiality services for recorded documents available online such as deeds and requires a separate application. Once your confidentiality has been approved, the fictitious name you selected will be displayed on the property record page when searching our website at web.bcpa.net. You will need to contact our office should you need your legal name restored online.
