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RESOLUTION NO. 2010 -

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE TOTAL SUM OF THE ANNUAL FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES SPECIAL ASSESSMENT; SETTING THE AMOUNT ASSESSED AGAINST EACH PARCEL OF PROPERTY FOR THE 2010-2011 FISCAL YEAR; PROVIDING FOR THE CONTINUED USE OF THE UNIFORM METHOD OF COLLECTION

WHEREAS, the City passed Ordinance No. 2000-16, as may be recodified, authorizing the imposition and collection of a fire protection services special assessment against property throughout the City, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 8 of Ordinance No. 2000-16, the City utilizes the uniform method for levy, collection and enforcement of the assessment, as authorized by Chapter 197, Florida Statutes, and

WHEREAS, the projected cost for providing fire protection services to properties within the City that derive a special benefit from the availability of fire protection services has been evaluated, and

WHEREAS, Section 15 of Ordinance No. 2000-16 authorizes the annual modification of the total amount of the fire protection services special assessment and the amount assessed against each parcel of property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The total annual cost for the provision of fire protection services to be paid through the levy and collection of special assessments against properties within the City is \$4,522,000 which represents 58.6 percent of the total fire protection services projected budget for the 2010-2011 fiscal year.

SECTION 2. In accordance with Ordinance No. 2000-16, and general law, properties are assessed for the 2010-2011 fiscal year in the following apportionment:

Residential:

Pari-mutuels	\$60,959.98	per facility
Institutional	\$ 33.16	per 100 square feet
Religious	Exempt	
Government	Exempt	

SECTION 3. The assessments shall be billed and collected as provided in Ordinance No. 2000-16 and shall be the annual assessment unless and until modified by Resolution.

SECTION 4. All other provisions of the assessment process are ratified and confirmed.
